Please take note of the following:

- 1) All entries for the meet must be submitted electronically through "Team Manager Export of Entries file" by Sunday, July 14, 2024, at 8:00 pm. Email the entries to Cari Zelko at clz89psu@verizon.net. Each team will receive a confirmation email to verify your team's entries by Monday, July 15, 2024, at 9:00 pm. Each team is responsible for verification of their entries submitted. Any corrections must be brought to the host team's attention no later than Tuesday, July 16, 2024, at 9:00 pm.
- 2) Entries must be made using <u>yard times</u> or converting from meters to yards. Use standard event numbers established by the league.

3) Payments

The Mid Penn Swim League will bill each team a \$5.00 surcharge per swimmer entered in Divisionals. This invoice will be sent to each team at the end of the season.

The host team will send an invoice to each team after the entries are finalized on Tuesday evening, July 16, 2024. Individual events are \$5.00 and Relays are \$20.00 That invoice will be due at the start of Divisionals on July 20, 2024 made payable to the Middletown Swim Team.

Parking:

There will be **NO PARKING** for swimmers/parents/spectators at the Hummelstown Pool, only coaches and volunteers may park at the pool. Swimmers and guests can be dropped off at the pool. The driver must drive to Lower Dauphin High School to park. Plan to arrive early to ensure enough travel time back from the parking area for the driver. **There will be no parking in the field adjacent to the Swim Club.**

Hummelstown will provide shuttle service between the pool and the Lower Dauphin High School from 6:30-9:00 AM and 11:30 AM-1:30 PM.

Parking on Kokomo Avenue is not allowed.

Warm Down Pool: The big pool will be open for warm-down for swimmers 12 and older **ONLY** between the designated area.

The warm down pool will open after the Girls 11-12 Medley Relay and close after the Girls 15-18 50 Fly.

All other pools and equipment are off limits.
